



WA targets dialysis funding

The Western Australian Government has granted more than \$500,000 to expand the renal dialysis unit at the Kalgoorlie Regional Hospital.

Health Minister Jim McGinty says from July eight patients will be transferred from Perth if they are well enough.

Mr McGinty says the increased capacity at the hospital will provide major benefits to country patients and their families.

He says extra funding was available after the Country Health Service worked hard to meet its budget this financial year.
