



## Dialysis unit seen as act of self-determination

The Kurra Aboriginal Corporation, which manages royalties from the Granites Mine in the Yuendumu area, has provided \$250,000 to the Western Desert Dialysis Service especially for the unit.

Central Land Council spokesman David Ross says he is proud of the local community for choosing to use the money wisely.

"We're now seeing these things and that they're possible, and that they're in the Aboriginal people's best interests," he said.

"It just makes me feel great that Aboriginal people are happy to go and do these things in their best interests."
